

St Cainnech/Kenneth (c516-600AD) was an Irish abbot, monastic founder, priest and missionary during the early medieval period. Cainnech is one of the Twelve Apostles of Ireland and preached Christianity across Ireland. In 565AD Cainnech joined Columba in Scotland and went onto evangelise the Picts. St Kenneth was the founder of a church and monastery in what now St Andrews the ruined Abbey of Cambuskenneth, just outside of Stirling, which still bears his name.






