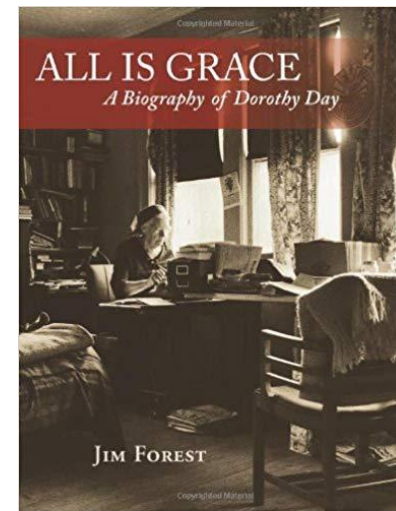
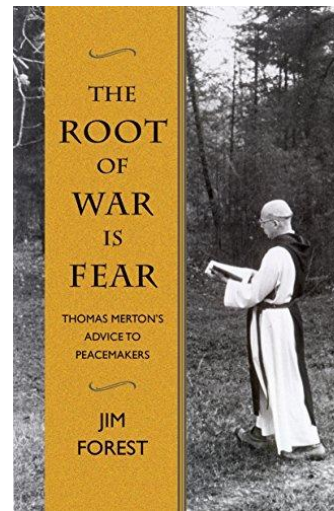
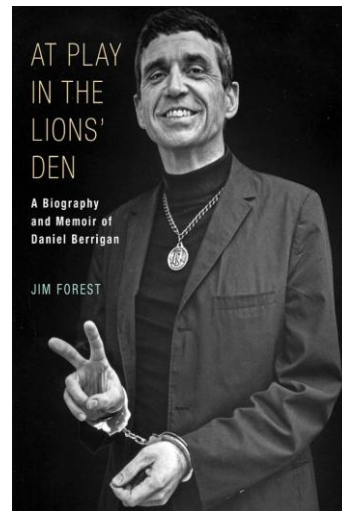


Jim Forest has been a tireless worker for peace since the early 1960s when was a co-founder of the Catholic Peace Fellowship.
