130 years ago, a Catholic presence was restored to Musselburgh and the surrounding area. This mission would eventually become a parish dedicated to the Patron of Musselburgh St Michael the Archangel but also remembering the late medieval shire established in the burgh to Our Lady of Loretto.

A mission is an activity, a parish a geographical territory. Perhaps Mission is a better name. It tells us what we are to do, it reminds us that we are missionary, what Pope Francis calls missionary disciples.

In virtue of our baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (Mt 28:19). All the baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization.

*‘Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: we no longer say that we are “disciples” and “missionaries,” but rather that we are always “missionary disciples.”*

## Requests for Baptism

Baptisms take place on the last Sunday of the month at 12.30pm, but can also take place any Sunday during Mass.

**Please note however that no baptisms take place during December and the last date for baptism in 2019 will be Sunday 24th November.**

A minimum of two months' notice is required and at least one parent should be a believing and practising Catholic. Therefore, requests for Baptisms to take place before the end of this year need to be submitted no later than Sunday 22nd September.

Baptism request forms can be collected from the Church after any weekday or weekend Mass.

Baptism is a wonderful invitation from God to know him as Father, and through Baptism we become part of the family of the Church.

Baptism will not be carried out for the sole purpose of gaining entry to a Catholic primary school.
