Primary schools: A reminder for parents of children who start school in August 2024: You will be required to register your child for school shortly (please check with your local school). If you intend for them to go to a Catholic school, they should be baptised before registration takes place. This will ensure they are given a place in cases where spaces are limited, as children who are Baptised Roman Catholics will take priority. This is also the case for Catholic secondary schools.

ALL SOULS

DON'T BE FRIGHTENED OF PURGATORY!

The Catechism of the Catholic Church defines purgatory as a "purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven," which is experienced by those "who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified" (CCC 1030)

Purgatory might then be thought of a 'journey' of transfiguration, as St Paul says: And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being changed into his likeness from one degree of glory to another; for this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit. 2 Cor 3:18.

This is picked up by the ancient liturgy of Jerusalem - the Liturgy of St James

From glory to glory advancing, we praise thee, O Lord; thy name with the Father and Spirit be ever adored. From strength unto strength, we go forward on Sion's highway, to appear before God in the city of infinite day.

Or Charles Wesley, the great methodist preacher and hymn writer: Changed from Glory into Glory, till in heav'n we take our place, till we cast our Crown before thee, lost in wonder love and praise!

So don't be frightened of purgatory but in our prayers and devotion help our loved ones grow in glory! Fr B
