REINTRODUCING HOLY COMMUNION under both kinds

At the last meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council this topic was raised. Clearly, we are all more conscious then ever of hygiene when receiving from the 'common cup' and yet it is a pity to lose the sign value of being able to receive Holy Communion as our Lord first intended.

It is true that when we receive the Host alone, we receive everything that Jesus is - his risen body, blood, soul and divinity. When we also receive the Precious Blood then we receive the same Jesus twice but under two different 'kinds' or appearances. Therefore, to receive either under the form of bread or wine is enough but again not what the Lord instructed at his Last Supper or as celebrated in the early church. So it's time to pray and reflect and try to get an intuition for what's right in our communities. Fr B
